Re: Provisional Applications for Reception 2020

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Further to the published proposals by the Congregation of Christian Brothers to establish a new voluntary aided primary school at Runnymede St Edward's, an extraordinary admissions round to Reception in September 2020 at the proposed school has now opened.

The proposals are still at a statutory proposal phase and a final decision about approving the school is expected to be made by the City Council before Easter.

In order to coordinate admissions to Reception for September 2020, the local authority have approved a provisional admissions round taking place in advance of that decision. This provisional admissions round should not be interpreted as pre-empting that decision in any way.

Parents will not be notified of places until such time as the proposed school is approved, and in any event not before national offer day (16th April 2020).

Enclosed is an application form and a copy of the 2020 admissions policy. For administrative purposes, forms must be returned to Runnymede St Edward's independent school by 4.00 pm on Monday 9th March 2020.
